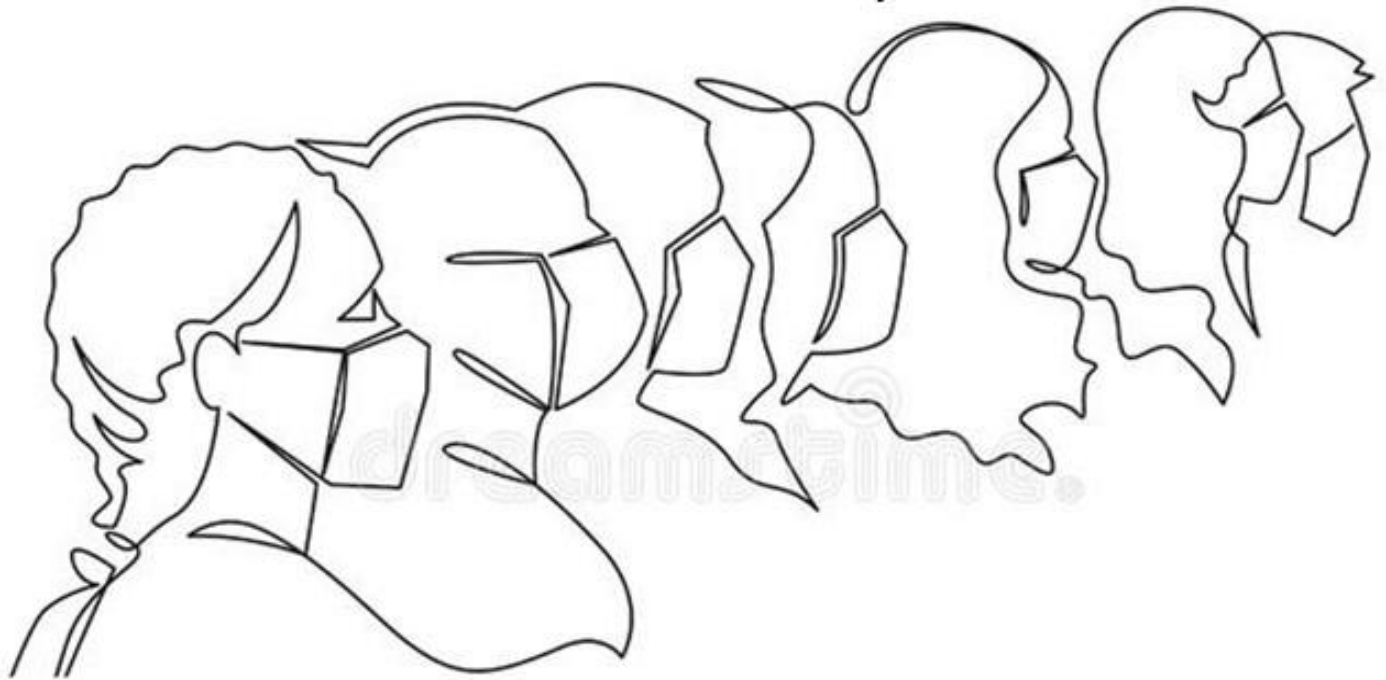

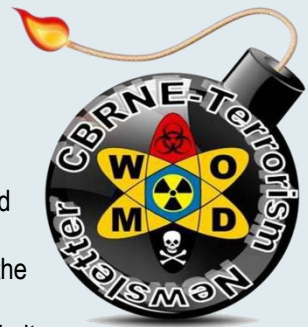

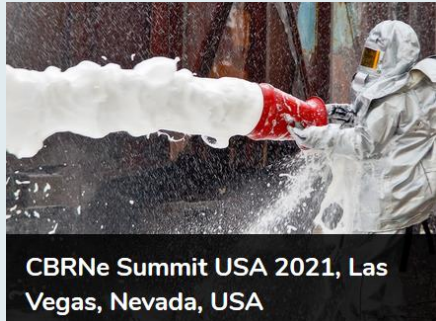

Boston and Massachusetts are well known in the US for having an extremely high competency when it comes to dealing with CBRN and Hazmat incidents. The phrase 'Boston Strong' has become world famous due to the tragic events of April 15, 2013. That event saw an already extremely competent capability taken to the next level. This three-day event will provide delegates with the chance to be able to learn from the best that Massachusetts and the rest of the world has to offer.

This is the 13th Annual CBRNe Convergence and comes on the back of runaway recent successes in Nashville, Orlando and Indianapolis. This three-day event has two pre-conference workshops, a two day streamed conference (that allows you to pick the information that matters to you), the largest exhibition of CBRN equipment in the US in 2020 and a dynamic demonstration.
